From your N.I.A. President:

Dear Members,

Let me wish you a merry Christmas, and a joyous and prosperous New Year. I know that part of the Linscotts Christmas gifts is going to be a reserved sales table and display table at the Herkimer, New York National. And of course we are not going to wait until the last minute to make these reservations. I believe that it would be a good idea for all N.I.A. members to let Grant Barnes know that you plan to attend- and try to do this at an early date. This is going to be one of the best N.I.A. shows that we've had in a long time. I've heard that New York and that part of the country has a lot of good glass and porcelain insulators. I also expect to see a lot of Canadian insulators at the show.

I talked to Bill Hungate the other day, and he told me that he is starting to accept names for the ballot for Eastern region VP, and, yes, N.I.A. President. If you wish to run for Eastern region VP, let him know. (just remember that you have to reside in that region) If you wish to run for N.I.A. President, submit your own name.- Don't forget that you must be a paid up member! I believe that Bill did an excellent job last year, and should have your full support this year.

Let me explain again that membership dues are \$6.00 per family or household. This lets all in the door on N.I.A. Day, be it one or ten, but anyone else in that household that wishes to have the voting privilege must pay an additional \$1.00. Also the one that has the initial membership is responsible for those taken into the National on N.I.A. Day. Anyone that says differently either doesn't know what the facts are... or, is trying to cause dissention. I know what the facts are, as I was present when this incident occurred at Denver.

Probably the biggest news item lately is the new insulator finds being made by bottle diggers at a redevelopment site near the Embarcadero in San Francisco! Several independent diggers, with permission from the trucking contractor to probe the removed dirt, have discovered a CD 723 smooth side Wade, TWO wood covered Dot & Dash Wades in mint condition with the original pins, and multiple LARGE pieces of P U C E colored CD 736 E R W's and N Y & E R R's! Another club group has made an agreement

with the contractor, and have come up with another wood covered Wade with pin, an E R W , and reportedly several other threadless! In addition to the insulators, a bonanza of pontiled inks, sodas, and other bottles have been found. All the previously mentioned Wades are different from any reported to date , in that the wood cover is FLAT on top! They appear to have been sawn off, possibly for some type of installation that did not have sufficient clearance for the full dome height. I intend to take some pictures and follow up with an article in Crown Jewels magazine. Thats all for now- any new info. will be in the next issue.
