

Crown Point, Indiana swap meet report

The January 26, 2013 "Beat the Winter Blahs" GCIC swap meet in Crown Point, Indiana was another wonderful success. The weather was nicer than in previous years with little snow to worry about, the food was good as usual, and plenty of insulators were available for sale.

The auction included a lot of insulators from freshly purchased collections as well as donations that helped the club earn quite a bit of money. In total, \$1156 in insulators exchanged hands in the auction. Of this, donations by Bob Stahr netted the club \$56 while the commission on the remaining sales added \$110, bringing the total income to the club to \$166. This amount covered the expenses of the swap meet very nicely. Full details of the auction follow.

After the auction, a club meeting was held. Arlen reported that the club treasury held \$3653 which was the amount before adding dues collected that day and proceeds from the auction. Expenses included the award given by the club at the National show for the best use of Power Insulators, dues to the NIA, a donation to the NIA, postage of \$67 to mail copies of the club newsletter, food at swap meets, and postage to send postcards notifying people of swap meets.

In a special tongue-in-cheek vote, several officers were installed into new club offices. Marge Frank was unanimously selected as the No Bake Cookie Maker. Riley Armstrong was appointed the Club Goodwill Ambassador to South Dakota. With Jim White missing from the swap meet, Steve McCollum had no trouble achieving the high honor of becoming Club Photographer. Russ Frank retained his position as Web Site Creator. Randy Wesner was selected as Head Club Commemorative Creator. Tim Haraf retained his title as Vice President. There were a few other positions filled but space prevents me from listing them all. New member Tim Clark made it to the swap meet and seemed to have a good time. He ended up winning several lots of insulators and took home quite a few additions to his collection.
