

Crown Point, Indiana Swap Meet Report

The January 31, 2015 swap meet hosted by Tina and Arlen Rienstra was blessed with moderate weather, distant travelers, and a full auction at this year's event. It was also challenged by a competing auction nearby and difficult weather for those traveling from afar.

Before the show, Andrew Gibson from New York found himself in the middle of a snow storm that would have resulted in his turning back if he had not entered it so gradually. After the show, severe weather coming from the west delayed Riley Armstrong's return to South Dakota until the afternoon of Sunday, February 1. During the show, however, the weather was clear and local collectors managed to get home before snow hit.

Rick Soller is normally the auctioneer at the swap meet but he brought insulators for the swap meet and then attended an auction in nearby La Porte, Indiana. Riley Armstrong was nice enough to conduct the first part of the auction in Rick's absence and Scott Reed stepped in and finished the auctioning. With Rick missing, Marge Frank handled the difficult task of compiling how much each buyer owed and how much each seller should receive minus the club commission. Russ Frank handled the recording details and his easy-to-read handwriting allowed the results to be presented below.

Auction sales reached \$740 which would have netted the club \$74 in commissions but several items were donated to the club for the auction. Donations by Roger Lucas were especially lucrative for the club as the glass blocks he contributed saw spirited bidding and his total donation brought in \$144. Although the donation eliminated \$14 in commission, it added \$130 in revenue resulting in \$210 going to the club after taking into account other donations by Arlen Rienstra, and Riley Armstrong.

Attendees also had the opportunity to buy insulators from several dealers. Dealers included Russ Frank, Arlen Rienstra, Gene Hawkins, Roger Lucas, Jay & Josh Dondorf, Mike McLaughlin, Tom Nugent, and Dan Ling. Mark Gilmore had a couple insulators for sale. Arlen had great deals on aqua CD 254 Hemingray No. 3 cables that came from a local steel mill. He had at least a dozen of them, one that went home to Gurnee, IL. Also ending up in Gurnee in Rick Soller's collection was a U-205 unmarked Lapp transposition in a pumpkin color from Jay Dondorf, and a junky CD 135 Chicago in blue from Dan Ling. Andrew Gibson added another CD 160 to his extensive collection of baby signals. It was the [080] version in Hemingray blue embossed on the front HEMINGRAY -14 / PETTICOAT and on the back MADE IN U.S.A ["H.G.Co." blotted out] / PATENT MAY 2 1893 with sharp drip points. Although it had a chip out of the wire ridge, he thought the piece was undervalued in the price guide at \$15-20 for VNM pieces and was happy to pay \$10 for it. Other collectors in attendance included Steve McCollum, April & Don Cook, Riley Armstrong, Bob Stahr, Rich Tillich, Richard Case, Les Christensen, Kim Borgman, Mark & Elaine Correiro, Pat Reed, and Scott Elliott.

A short club meeting was held after lunch and the end of the auction. Bob Stahr gave a

report on this year's National show to be held in Yorkville, IL and raised the idea of planning for a National show in 2018 in Muncie, Indiana when a new hotel will be completed there, providing enough hotel rooms to support such a show. Dues were collected from members. If you haven't paid, please send your check to Bob.

After the show, I received further information from the treasurer. After deposits of monies collected at the swap meet, the club had \$3944.88 in the treasury. This amount includes \$180 for expenses of the swap meet and NIA club dues of \$50 (up from \$12) but does not include the cost of mailing newsletters last year, the postage to mail postcards promoting the swap meet, nor a proposed contribution to ICON.
