The 2022 NIA National Show and Convention on July 29th – 31st is in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. The Wyndham Gettysburg is located two short miles from the Battlefield that changed the course of our Nation's History. The Hotel is surrounded by countless historic sites, as well as outlet malls, antique stores, and family friendly venues for all ages. The Wyndham has a helpful concierge service to assist you in finding activities external to those offered by the National Show.



All activities for the show occur at the Wyndham. The Presidential Ballroom serves as our main show hall with 8,901 square feet, while the NIA General Membership meeting and NIA Awards Banquet take place in the 5,360 square foot Pre-Function Space. Adjacent smaller rooms facilitate the board meeting, special displays, etc. The building is air conditioned, with WiFi access throughout. There is ample parking, and all loading and unloading are at ground level. The Chesapeake Bay Insulator Club is the overall sponsor for the NIA National Show, while your show hosts are:



The Wyndham Gettysburg is conveniently located at the intersection of US 15 & US 30 in Gettysburg in close proximity to: Harrisburg (36 miles), Baltimore (54 miles), Washington DC (78 miles) and Philadelphia (118 miles). Designed with a heightened appreciation of its historic setting, Gateway Gettysburg is a wonderful shopping, dining & entertainment complex located on a pedestrian friendly 100 acre campus.

The Presidential Ballroom will accommodate 126 Dealer Tables 18 Exhibit Tables. Tables are 6' long and 30" wide. The aisles and dealer space will be 6' wide. Dealers with Insulators, related go-withs, bottles, etc. are all invited. Dealer tables will be \$50 each. Optionally, electricity is available for \$25 per dealer, wired to your table. All tables come with a white table cloth covering, at no additional charge. Staying setup until the close of the show is strongly recommended.




The Presidential Ballroom, Wyndham Gettysburg



NIA and Chesapeake Bay Insulator Club volunteers provide security during set-up and show hours. We lock the show hall during non-show hours and there will be no access. We provide dealer and exhibitor table signs and ID Badges to help with identification. Dealers and exhibitors receive complimentary show programs, which are available to all others for \$2.

Loading and unloading are at ground level, and we will provide hand trucks at no charge. Lunch is available on site daily from the 1863 Restaurant and Lounge, Getty's Market, and the Appalachian Brewing Company.

The admission charge is \$4 per person and free to dealers and exhibitors. Friday is NIA day, with attendance limited to NIA members in good standing, including Dealers and exhibitors.



Lodging





The host hotel is the Wyndham Gettysburg, located at 95 Presidential Circle, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania 17325, (717) 339-0020. The Wyndham is holding a block of rooms until June 27, 2022, after the cutoff Date, the hotel will review the reservation pickup for the Event, release the unreserved rooms for general sale, and determine whether it can accept reservations based on a space- and rate-available basis or at the NIA 2022 group rate after this date.

The room rate for the show is \$139 per night plus tax. It includes complementary parking and WiFi. The room rate DOES NOT include complimentary breakfast. The Wyndham will honor the group rate, as noted, for three (3) consecutive days pre (24-26 July) and post (1-3 August) the NIA National Show and Convention. July is the anniversary month for the Battle of Gettysburg, so hotels fill up rapidly. Be sure to make your reservations early. All individual cancellations must be made 24 hours prior to the date of arrival.

In the event that we sell out, the Courtyard by Marriott Gettysburg, 115 Presidential Circle, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania 17325 (717) 334-5600, is next door the Wyndham, and will honor our room rate of \$139 per night. For those traveling by Recreational Vehicle, there are numerous RV Campgrounds within a 10 mile radius of the Wyndham.



Gettysburg Tour

Gettysburg Museum: Set the framework for your visit and prepare for a tour of the battlefield with the Film, Cyclorama & Museum Experience. Board your bus with a Licensed Battlefield Guide or meet your guide onsite for your personalized car tour to begin your Gettysburg Battlefield tour. Connect to the battlefield and its stories through National Park Service interpretive programs.



Gettysburg Cyclorama: Before feature films. Before IMAX. Before virtual reality. There was the cyclorama. The must-see entertainment of the 1880s, cycloramas were the blockbuster movies of their time. Often depicting epic battles or historical places, the enormous, paintings-in-theround transported viewers into the middle of the fray; surrounding them with a 360-degree, hand-painted canvas longer than a football field and higher than a four-story building. Created by French artist Paul Philippoteaux in 1884, The Battle of Gettysburg Cyclorama depicts the fury of Pickett's Charge during the decisive third day of fighting. Reviews of the time called it "marvelous," "remarkable" and "must be seen."

Gettysburg Battlefield Bus Tour: Travel the historic fields of Gettysburg in the comfort of an air-conditioned guided tour bus and watch history come alive through the eyes of a licensed guide. Enjoy a truly unique perspective into the three-day Battle of Gettysburg. Our guided battlefield tours provide visitors with the most informative and detailed tour available in Gettysburg. All guided bus tours are conducted by guides licensed by the Gettysburg National Military Park.

Harrisburg Tour

Harrisburg Capitol: The Pennsylvania State Capitol is the seat of government for the U.S. state of Pennsylvania located in downtown Harrisburg which was designed by architect Joseph Miller Huston in 1902 and completed in 1906 in a Beaux-Arts style with decorative Renaissance themes throughout.





The Pride of the Susquehanna: The Pride of the Susquehanna Riverboat is an iconic Harrisburg attraction and one of the last remaining paddlewheel riverboats in America. The Pride has sailed this stretch of the Susquehanna River for more than 30 years, carrying more than one million passengers. Discover the unique history of The Pride and how you can take a tour or dinner cruise this season!

PRR Station: For well over 100 years, the Harrisburg Train Station, now known as the Harrisburg Transportation Center, has served as a gateway to Pennsylvania's state capital. Opened in 1887 by the mighty Pennsylvania Railroad and built adjacent to Harrisburg's business district and the capital city's monumental core, the railroad passenger station was a major portal to the city, serving politicians, heads of state, tourists, local residents, and commuters. It continues to serve a major role in Pennsylvania's multimodal transportation system—modernized yet retaining its historic character

Hershey's Chocolate World: Discover all things chocolatey and fun at Hershey's Chocolate World Attraction! Embark on a journey to learn and see how chocolate is made on a free tour ride, share and savor delicious Hershey's-inspired drinks and treats, shop for one-of-a-kind souvenirs and gifts, and have a chocolate-inspired adventure to remember!

TO BAO CH

General Rules of Conduct

All participants shall abide by the NIA Code of Ethics. In particular:

Participants shall not knowingly misrepresent the condition, rarity, or value of insulators or related items they offer for sale or trade.

Imitation and Altered insulators or related items may only be brought onto the show premises if they are PERMANENTLY MARKED or embossed so as to indicate their lack of authenticity. While the NIA Code of Ethics requires Imitation or Altered Insulators to be plainly marked "reproduction" and "fake" respectively, it does not require Questionable Insulators (those which may not be Original Insulators), to be permanently marked. The goal of this rule is to cause a prospective purchaser to easily recognize that an item is a reproduction or fake, or to cause them to question its authenticity. Insulators of questionable authenticity should should be represented with candor. If not, a Show Organizer(s) can require a participant to remove the item from a sales table. The decision of the Show Organizer shall be final. NIA Board Members attending a NIA sponsored show will provide active assistance, if requested by a Show Organizer, in resolving violations of NIA rules.

All restored and/or repaired items on sales tables must be clearly labeled as such.

All show participants and the attending public shall abide by any site-specific show rules set by the Show Organizer(s) including all applicable State laws, local ordinances, restrictions imposed by the owner of the facility, etc.

Positively no public attendance during show setup hours.

"Aisle dealing" by the attending public is discouraged.

It will not be permissible for dealers to "work the aisles" in any fashion which preempts the opportunities of fellow dealers.

Dealer side shows (spotlights, excessive "cow bell ringing,: etc.) shall not be carried to the point of being abusive to fellow dealers and the general public.

Dealers will not sublet portions of their reserved tables without first consulting with the show host and obtaining permission. Dealer packets, novelties, etc. will only be given to the dealer reserving the table, not helpers nor other dealers sharing the table. Anyone using part of a dealer's table must also be a NIA member in good standing.

Participants shall keep aisles in front of tables free of boxes and clutter.

Participants are encouraged to cover their unattended tables.

Dealers should keep their sales tables intact until the end of the published show date and time. There may be exceptions made for those driving long distances or needing to make other travel connections, but advance arrangements should be made with the Show Organizer(s) when reserving the table. The Show Organizer(s) reserves the right to locate such tables on the outer aisles or near exits to avoid disruption of the rest of the show with any early departures. The Show Organizer(s) may announce blanket authority for early takedown at such time as public attendance appears to have ceased.

Participants will be responsible for any damage they do to the facilities with their setup practices (i.e. no signs or other items taped or tacked to walls or furnishings).

The Show Organizer(s) will make every effort to provide good security, but will not be responsible for any loss of participant property due to theft or breakage. Each dealer and exhibitor is asked to help with security by watching after their own items and keeping an eye on adjacent tables.

All National Show dealers, helpers, and exhibitors must be NIA members in good standing. All attendees on any NIA day must be NIA members in good standing.

Dealers are required to obtain a Pennsylvania Special Event Sales Tax License and pay the appropriate tax on their sales. Information may be found at: www.pa100.state.pa.us. Dealers may arrange for their license in advance. Forms and information will also be available at the show.

The reservation of a table at a NIA sponsored show constitutes the acceptance of these rules and agreement to comply with them.
